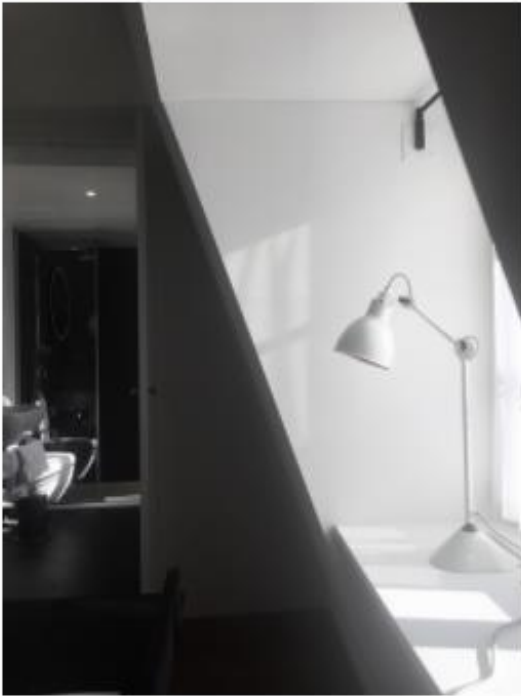
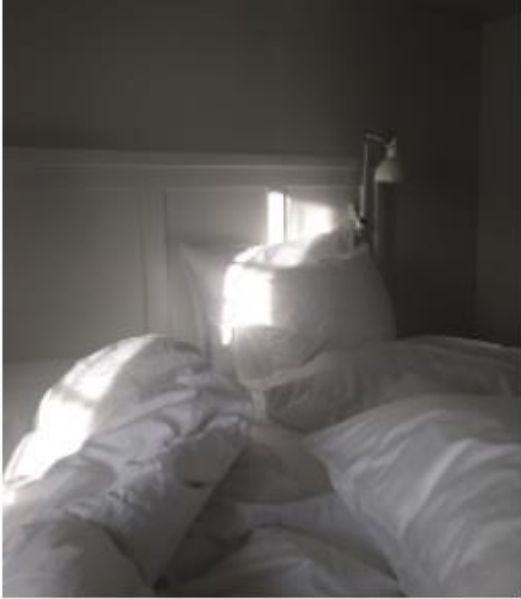




# RECREATE THE LOOK OF THE MARKTGASSE HOTEL
